

On 29 February 2016, Gender Concerns International hosted a participatory roundtable event at the CNDH Training Centre in Rabat, Morocco. The aim of the roundtable was to engage with various Moroccan Civil Society Organizations on the following topics:

- 1. Women's political participation on the local and national level, in particular regard to electoral reforms and regional reform policies.
- 2. On the subject of women's participation in the election process, including election observation, with a focus on the September 2015 elections.
- 3. On women's social and political empowerment.

In partnership with the CNDH, the FLDDF, and the CDG, Gender Concerns successfully facilitated a productive conversation to debate the socio-political situation of women in Morocco. With the involvement of Civil Society Organizations in this roundtable, a joint agreement with 25 recommendations to improve women's position in Morocco was drawn up.
