Women all over the world undertake multiple roles during this pandemic while also working full-time from home. They contribute to the collective response to Covid-19 becoming full-time caregivers, teachers, cleaners, chefs, and much more.

An all-girls robotics team in Afghanistan is building easily accessible and cheap ventilators, using only automobile parts in order to help as many Covid-19 patients as possible.



Women globally face risks when staying at home during the Covid-19 outbreak as domestic abusers have greater opportunities for emotional, physical and sexual abuse. Some governments have already taken action against this, like Canada who designated \$50 million for women's shelters and sexual assault centres and the UK who allows victims to leave isolation and seek refuge elsewhere.

The UN-sponsored HerStory youth-led movement is actively seeking to monitor and report misinformation in Arabic language about Covid-19 across 15 Arab states through the commitment of 300 young volunteers.
